

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

When and where to use: Plant Pest Killer RTU is a

broad spectrum insecticide for the control of insect pests such as aphids and caterpillars on roses and other ornamentals. Do not apply when bees are actively foraging (use early in the morning or late in the evening).

How to use: Spray plants thoroughly, including the underside of the leaves.

Crop	Application rate	Maximum number of treatments	Minimum interval between treatments
Ornamental plants	300ml treats 3 to 6 m ²	2 per year	10 days
